NETBALL CANADA

Netball Canada is Canada's national governing body. Canada has both men's and women's national teams. Today, netball is played primarily in Québec, Ontario, Alberta and British Columbia.

Netball is a ball sport and a variant of basketball initially designed for women and girls. The team sport is played largely in English-speaking countries. After its initial development in England, the sport spread throughout the Commonwealth and was introduced into Canada in the early 1960s. The first netball games played in Canada took place in Montréal in 1962.

The "Canadian Amateur Netball Association", now called "Netball Canada", was formed in 1973 and held the first national Canadian netball championship in 1975.

Canada's national netball teams compete on the world stage through the regional Americas Federation of Netball Associations (AFNA) competitions and qualifying tournaments to gain entry into the Commonwealth Games and the Netball World Cup.

As of 12th August 2022, Canada was 29th in the World Netball Rankings from 41 Nations.



The Netball World Cup

The Netball World Cup is a quadrennial international netball world championship organised by World Netball. The competition has been dominated primarily by Australia and New Zealand. The most recent tournament was held in 2019 in Liverpool, England, and was won by New Zealand. Other top nations include England, Trinidad and Tobago, South Africa and Jamaica.

The next World Cup is scheduled for 2023 in Cape Town, South Africa.

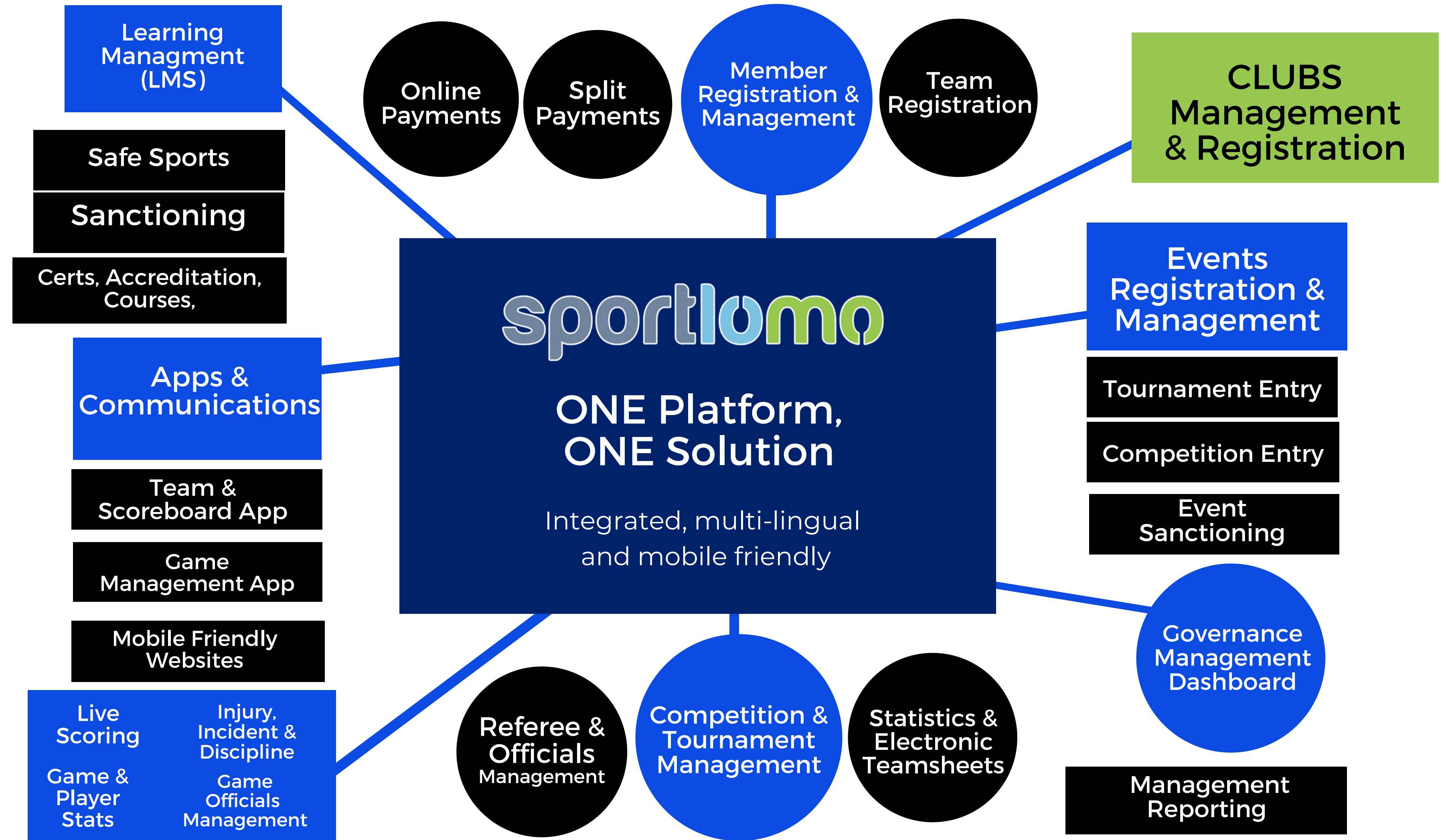
Alberta use Split Payments to Collect Membership Fees

Split Payments allow clubs, provinces, associations and National organisations to be all paid up front.

As an individual pays their membership fee, it is automatically split and distributed to each layer in the sport organization (deposited directly to each bank account). The member has only one transaction on their credit card.
